

Metropolitan Tikhon serves with Ecumenical Patriarch Bartholomew at Orthodoxy Sunday Liturgy

ISTANBUL, TURKEY – His Beatitude, Metropolitan Tikhon concelebrated the Divine Liturgy with His All-Holiness, Ecumenical Patriarch Bartholomew of Constantinople and members of the Patriarchal Holy Synod in the Patriarchal Church of Saint George on the Sunday of Orthodoxy – March 20, 2016. Metropolitan Tikhon's visit came in response to the invitation of His All-Holiness.

Metropolitan Tikhon had accepted similar invitations in recent years. In 2014, he visited the Holy Theological School of Halki and the Patriarchate with Archpriests John Jillions, OCA Chancellor, and Archpriests John Behr and Alexander Rentel of Saint Vladimir's Seminary. In 2015, he and Father Alexander also visited the Patriarchate in connection with the meeting of the Executive Committee of the Assembly of Canonical Orthodox Bishops of the USA.

Accompanied by Father John Jillions, Metropolitan Tikhon met with Patriarch Bartholomew in his office, at which time Metropolitan Tikhon offered greetings on behalf of the Holy Synod of Bishops of the Orthodox Church in America.

"Metropolitan Tikhon and His All-Holiness discussed the Great and Holy Council, His Beatitude's recent visit to Archbishop Leo and the Church of Finland, the work of the Assembly of Canonical Orthodox Bishops in the USA, and prospects for renewed formal dialogue with the Patriarchate concerning Orthodox unity and regularizing the canonical situation in North America," said Father John. "His All-Holiness, in turn, welcomed the discussion, recalling his discussions of these

Holy Synod elects Bishop Alexander to vacant Dallas See

SYOSSET, NY – During their Spring Session at the Chancery March 29–April 1, 2016, the members of the Holy Synod of Bishops of the Orthodox Church in America elected His Grace, Bishop Alexander of Toledo and the Bulgarian Diocese to fill the vacant See of Dallas and the South.

Bishop Alexander succeeds His Eminence, the late Archbishop Dmitri, who in retirement fell asleep in the Lord at the age of 87 on August 28, 2011.

In separate letters announcing the election to the clergy of the Diocese of the South and the Bulgarian Diocese, Metropolitan Tikhon noted that Bishop Alexander will continue to oversee the Bulgarian Diocese. An archpastoral letter to the faithful of the Diocese of the South was posted on the OCA web site and sent to the faithful of the Diocese of the South on March 31.

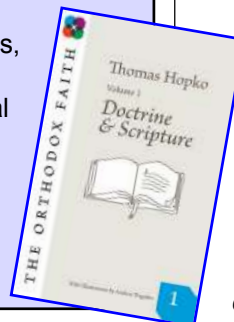

Deacon Mikel Hill delivered a paper titled “Hierarchy as Revelation: The Contribution of the Corpus Dionysium to the Appreciation of the Hierarchal Structure of the Liturgical Assembly.” “The Nestorian Implications of Severan Christology” was the topic of Marshall Goodge’s paper, while Jonathan Lincoln’s presentation was titled “Universal Salvation: Saint Gregory of Nyssa in Light of Saint Mark of Ephesus.” All three seminarions also offered responses to other presentations.
