FIT Co-Chair

This Individual should possess organizational skills and attention to detail. They will co-chair the Festival Implementation Team (FIT) with the HDF Chairperson, work closely with our Executive Committee, and be responsible for all aspects of the HDF Weekend. They oversee the FIT Committee including our Judge Coordinator, and Weekend Manager. This team member should have experience with our dance culture and weekend, and must have the written recommendation of their parish priest. Applicants may not be current Dance Directors or planning to compete in HDF during their appointment.

Minimum Age of 25, but maturity will be a factor in selection

Communications Applied This position is crucial to ensure a successful festival by overseeing our various methods of communication. The applicant will manage the HDF website, send communication to the participants, and update our Facebook, Twitter, and Instagram accounts. Much of the responsibility will be prior to the weekend, but they will continue to provide updates on social media throughout the weekend and assist with creating and administering the post-event survey to capture feedback from the participants.

This efficient and detail minded individual will take and distribute minutes at all scheduled HDF committee meetings. They will also assist in reviewing contracts, preparing correspondence on behalf of the committee, and oversee the review and distribution of the HDF By-Laws and Weekend Event Manual.

Registration Applied This position is key to a successful weekend. The individual should be computer savvy, have the ability to answer questions throughout the registration period, assist with the final hotel guarantee numbers, and trouble shoot registration issues that could arise. This person oversees Registration throughout the HDF weekend, and should be available from early August through the weekend.

Finance Candidates for this position possess a financial background, combined with an understanding of working with church sponsored events. The applicant will prepare monthly financial statements, and advise the Executive Committee on expenditures, budgets, and all things financial. They oversee the financial transactions onsite during HDF and at the conclusion of the weekend provide outstanding payments to our vendors.

At-Large Liaison

A new addition to our structure, this applicant will represent the general membership of our metropolis. An ideal candidate is someone who is committed to the program and has participated in at least 3 HDF weekends over the past 5 years. They should be connected to the dance community within our metropolis and provide meaningful feedback, concerns, and suggestions to the committee. A parent of a dancer and/or a former director would be excellent in this role.

A focused individual, with an understanding of financial planning and international travel would excel in this position. They would organize and plan the Annual Odyssey Trip to Greece, working directly with the Executive Committee. This person would work closely with dance organizations, churches, and facilities abroad, in order to create an enriching experience for all participants, while keeping in mind the budgetary constraints. Proficiency in Greek is preferred but not required. The Odyssey Trip itinerary should be age appropriate and allow those selected to gain a greater appreciation for, and experience of, our rich Hellenic culture.
