

The following should be put inside a 5-gallon bucket with resealable lid:

- Five scouring pads
- Seven sponges, assorted sizes
- One scrub brush
- Eighteen cleaning towels (reusable) like *Easy Wipes*
- One 50-78 oz. box dry laundry detergent
- One 12 oz. bottle of liquid concentrated household cleaner
- One 25 oz. bottle liquid disinfectant dish soap
- Fifty clothes pins
- Clothes line, two 50 ft. or one 100 ft.
- Five dust masks
- Two pairs latex gloves
- One pair work gloves
- One 22-27 count box heavy-duty trash bags (33-45 gallon)
- One 6-14 oz. bottle of insect repellent (drops or lotion, not aerosol)

**\*\*All liquids should be in plastic bottles and all items should be new and unopened\*\***

## HOW CAN I HELP?

We are asking each Parish to collect funds/items to put together Emergency Clean-Up Buckets . Each bucket will run about \$90.

- Parishes who wish to partner with other Deanery parishes should coordinate with their assigned Deanery representative who will be in contact with each parish.
- Work with Deanery representative to arrange for pick up or drop off of assembled buckets to a central location.
- Parishes that are very distant from Baltimore (i.e. Chicago, Florida Deaneries) or smaller parishes wishing to take on a less costly project may want to consider assembling Emergency Hygiene Kits, instead and sending them directly to IOCC.
- The Need is IMMEDIATE so please do so as quickly as possible!!!!
