SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY

1. All applicants must be graduating high school seniors who have been accepted for admission to a school of higher learning.
2. All applicants must be children or grandchildren of members who are currently “in good standing” (current year dues must be paid by March 15th) of Alexander Hamilton Chapter #54.
3. Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of academic achievement while maintaining strong ties to Hellenism.
4. In the event that Alexander Hamilton Chapter #54 has no applicants from the current membership of our AHEPA family, applications may be extended to the children of members of the local Greek community.
5. Awards will be determined by the Scholarship Committee, based on various factors, including, but not limited to, your application, and the availability of funds.

SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

1. Complete the application and submit with required documents by **March 31st**.
 - a) Official transcript of the applicant’s scholastic records. Please have your guidance counselor or someone responsible indicate your GPA on a 4.0 scale.
 - b) Final school rank as of date of application (if applicable).
 - c) Official test scores given for the SAT or ACT (or equivalent).
 - d) Resume indicating your participation in extracurricular school activities and/or community service.
 - e) Two letters of recommendation from faculty members of the school attended.
 - f) 300-600 word essay.
 - g) High resolution (300 pixels) .jpeg file of your senior portrait (with no markings).
 - h) **Your submittal should be in one email with multiple attachments.** 3rd Party documents, such as letter of recommendation, may be submitted separately.
