With these words that we all proclaimed on the Sunday of Orthodoxy, there can be no greater statement as to the importance of faith in our human existence. What we confess as Orthodox Christians is that we have freely chosen to walk through this portal of faith to believe in the experiences, the teachings, and the living witnesses that recognize Jesus Christ as the Lord and Master of our life. On March 25th we celebrated the Bicentennial of the Greek Revolution of 1821, the beginning of the War for Independence from the Ottoman Empire. The whole past month students learned about the Ottoman occupation, the heroes of the Revolution and the rebirth of our Nation. Our school will commemorate the event with a program at the end of the school year.

We are happy to announce that we are working on bringing our students back

into our classrooms!

On March 3rd the Greek School committee met and discussed plan options. It was decided for in-person instruction to begin on Fridays, in the month of May, after Pascha break. All protocols and guidelines regarding Covid-19 will be strictly followed.

For the 2021-22 school year, full in-person classes for grades K-6th will be offered. 7th-8th will remain online. Class sizes will be limited to 10-12 students. Registration will open on April 15th for everyone, and it will be on a first come, first serve basis (current students and St. Spyridon Church stewards will have priority). Space will be limited, so act fast when registration opens. More details regarding registration are on the application forms coming out soon.



ΑΓΙΑ ΚΑΙ ΜΕΓΑΛΗ ΕΒΔΟΜΑΔΑ

Η συνταφακτικότεφη εβδομάδα της ανθφώπινης ιστοφίας είναι αναμφίβολα η Μεγάλη Εβδομάδα. Βαθύτατα θεολογική και ιδιαίτεφα κατανυκτική αποτελεί πηγή ανανέωσης και ψυχικής καθάφσεως για όλους τους χφιστιανούς, οι οποίοι μετέχοντες στις ιεφές ακολουθίες των ημεφών αυτών βιώνουν το μυστήφιο της λυτφώσεως του ανθφώπινου γένους και του καθενός μας.

Λέγεται Μεγάλη Εβδομάδα όχι γιατί έχει περισσότερες μέρες, αλλά «επειδή μεγάλα ημίν γέγονεν κατορθώματα, η χρονιά του διαβόλου τυραννίς κατελύθη, ο θάνατος εσβέσθη, η αμαρτία ανηρέθη, η κατάρα κατελύθη, ο παράδεισος ηνεώχθη», όπως προσφυώς αναφέρει ο ιερός Χρυσόστομος.

Η Αγία και Μεγάλη Εβδομάδα σε συνδυασμό πάντοτε με την πανευφρόσυνη γιορτή του Πάσχα αποτελεί τη σημαντικότερη περίοδο της ορθόδοξης λατρείας. Είναι μία εβδομαδιαία μυσταγωγική πορεία, που οδηγεί τον πιστό στη βίωση του σωτήριου Πάθους του Χριστού και την πλήρωση της θείας περί τον άνθρωπον οικονομίας για τη σωτηρία του. Είναι εντελώς αδύνατο να επιτύχουμε την πνευματική μέθεξη στο μυστήριο του Σταυρού και να απολαύσουμε την εκ των ένδον θέα και μνήμη των γεγονότων των τελευταίων



ημερών της επί γης παρουσίας του Θεανθρώπου Ιησού Χριστού, έξω από τον ιερό χώρο της Εκκλησίας και χωρίς τη μετοχή μας στις πνευματικότατες εκκλησιαστικές ακολουθίες των ημερών της Μεγάλης Εβδομάδας με τα επιλεγμένα ιερά αναγνώσματα, και της σπάνιας ποιητικής ομορφιάς και δογματικής πυκνότητας ύμνους, οι οποίοι μας ανεβάζουν σε ψιλές σφαίρες πνευματικής κατάνυξης και ψυχικής ανάβασης.

Έξω από τον ιερό χώρο του ναού η Αγία Εβδομάδα, το Θείο Πάθος, ο Σταυρός γίνονται απλά λογοτεχνία, θέατρο, στοχαστική διάλεξη ή ευκαιρία επανάληψης λαογραφικών εθίμων. Μέσα στον ιερό χώρο της Εκκλησίας η Αγία Εβδομάδα γίνεται για τον χριστιανό μία συνοδοιπορία με τον Χριστό. Αν δε «συμπορευθώμεν αυτώ και συσταυρωθώμεν» δε θα μπορέσουμε ούτε και στην Ανάσταση να φθάσουμε μαζί του, «να συναναστηθώμεν», που σηματοδοτεί και τη δική μας ανάσταση από τη νέκρωση της αμαρτίας.

Αυτή η πορεία από το Πάθος της Σταυρώσεως στο υπέρλαμπρο φως της Αναστάσεως εμποδίζει τον χριστιανό να δει τη Μεγάλη Εβδομάδα μέσα σ' ένα ζοφερό και καταλυτικό σκοτάδι, γιατί είναι ντυμένος με το ζεστό ένδυμα της χαρμολύπης. Σ' αυτή την πνευματική πορεία που βρίσκεται πάντα κάτω από τη σκιά του Σταυρού και αντικρύζει στο βάθος τον φωτεινό λόφο της Αναστάσεως, οι Άγιοι Πατέρες έβαλαν μερικά σημάδια σαν ορόσημα, σαν σκαλοπάτια, που μας βοηθούν μ' έναν ειδικό το καθένα τρόπο, να βιώσουμε από το βράδυ της Κυριακής των Βαΐων μέχρι και το Μεγάλο Σάββατο το Θείο Πάθος, την πορεία του Κυρίου προς τη Σταύρωση, τη θεόσωμο ταφή και τη ζωηφόρο Ανάσταση.


Αυτά τα σημάδια είναι το τί έχει ορίσει η Εκκλησία να εορτάζεται, να θυμόμαστε κάθε μέρα αυτό που ακούμε στο συναξάρι, που διαβάζεται στον Όρθρο, ο οποίος τελείται το βράδυ της προηγούμενης μέρας (ο εσπερινός τελείται το πρωί της ημέρας). Έτσι τη Μεγάλη Δευτέρα η Εκκλησία μας προβάλλει την

ποοσωπικότητα του πάγκαλου Ιωσήφ, ο οποίος με ο,τι υπέστη υπήοξε τύπος Χοιστού και την ξερανθείσα άκαρπη συκή, για να μας θυμίζει ότι στη ζωή μας πρέπει να παράγουμε έργα και καρπούς πνευματικούς. Τη Μεγάλη Τρίτη «της των δέκα παρθένων παραβολής μνείαν ποιούμεθα», για να μας διδάξει η Εκκλησία την ανάγκη της πνευματικής προετοιμασίας και της εγρήγορσης αλλά και της ελεήμονος προσφοράς, που αρνήθηκαν οι πέντε φρόνιμες στις πέντε μωρές παρθένες. Παραινετικά η Εκκλησία μας μας προτρέπει να μιμηθούμε τις φρόνιμες παρθένες με τον υπέροχο ύμνο του Νυμφίου: «βλέπε ουν, ψυχή μου, μη τω ύπνω κατενεχθής, ίνα μη τω θανάτω παραδοθής και της βασιλείας έξω κλειθείς».

Την Μεγάλη Τετάςτη προβάλλεται η μετάνοια της αμαςτωλής γυναίκας, που γνώςισε την αληθινή μετάνοια ως σύμβολο ελπίδας για κάθε αμαςτωλό και για να κεντςισθεί και η δική μας βούληση γι' αυτή τη σωτήςια μεταστροφή. Ψάλλεται το επίκαιςο και τόσο δημοφιλές τςοπάςιο, που έγςαψε η μοναχή Κασσιανή: «Κύςιε, η εν πολλαίς αμαςτίαις πεςιπεσούσα γυνή...». Η Αγία και Μεγάλη Πέμπτη είναι αφιεςωμένη στον Ιεςό Νιπτήςα, που μας διδάσκει την ταπεινοφοσσύνη. Στον Μυστικό Δείπνο στον οποίο ο Χςιστός συνέστησε το μυστήςιο της Θείας Ευχαςιστίας και εγκαινίασε την πραγματική κοινωνία με τον Σωτήςα μας, στην υπεςφυά προσευχή του Χςιστού στο όρος των ελαιών και την προδοσία του Ιούδα, που σηματοδοτεί την αρχή του Πάθους του Κυςίου μας. Τη Μεγάλη Παρασκευή (ημεςολογιακά τη Μεγάλη Πέμπτη το βράδυ) έχουμε κοςύφωση του Θείου δράματος. Τελείται η «ακολουθία των Παθών», η οποία πεςιλαμβάνει αραιότατους εκκλησιαστικούς ύμνους μεταξύ των οποίων και το «Σήμεςον κρεμμάται επί ξύλου» και αναγινώσκονται 12 Ευαγγέλια μέσα από τα οποία βιώνουμε όλους τους εξευτελισμούς, τη σταύρωση και τον θάνατο που υπέστη ο Κύςιος μας δίνοντας τον εαυτό του «λύτρον αντί πολλών».

Το Μεγάλο Σάββατο (δηλαδή τη Μεγάλη Παρασκευή βοάδυ) εορτάζεται η θεόσωμος ταφή και η εις Άδου Κάθοδος του Κυρίου μας Ιησού Χριστού· (έχει προηγηθεί τη Μεγάλη Παρασκευή το πρωί η ακολουθία της Αποκαθηλώσεως του Κυρίου από τον Σταυρό). Το βράδυ τελείται στους ιερούς ναούς η ακολουθία του Επιταφίου και ψάλλονται τα υπέροχα εγκώμια: «Η ζωή εν τάφω...», «Άξιον εστίν...», και «Αι γενεαί πάσαι...» και γίνεται μέσα σε ατμόσφαιρα ευλάβειας και ιερής κατάνυξης η περιφορά του Επιταφίου, με τη συμμετοχή πλήθους κόσμου. Το Μεγάλο Σάββατο το πρωί τελείται ο εσπερινός της Αναστάσεως, αυτό που ο κόσμος ονομάζει Α' Ανάσταση και ακούεται στους ναούς η προτροπή του ιερέως: «Ανάστα ο Θεός, κρίνων την γην...». Τρισμακάριοι αυτοί που θα μπορέσουν την εβδομάδα αυτή να αφήσουν τις βιοτικές τους μέριμνες και ν' αρχίσουν την ευλογημένη πορεία δίπλα στον πορευόμενο προς τα πάθος Χριστό: «δεύτε ουν και ημείς συμπορευθώμεν αυτώ και συσταυρωθώμεν και νεκρωθώμεν δι' αυτ'ον ταις του βίου ηδοναίς» ίνα μη μείνωμεν έξω του Νυμφώνος Χριστού.
