Annunciation Church Scholarship 2024

Awarded to: Students in pursuit of post-secondary education- including technical and vocational programs

The Greek Orthodox Church of the Annunciation has established a Church Scholarship to be used to support individuals who are pursuing post-secondary education.

We invite Orthodox Christians who are members of good standing in the Greek Orthodox Church of the Annunciation of Dover, NH, and who are accepted/enrolled students in an accredited/approved post- secondary institution to apply for scholarship consideration. All applications will be held in strict confidence. Basis for scholarship include: (1) Service to the Church Community,

- (2) Academic Merit, and
- (3) Community Service.
- (4)Applicants must be between the ages of 17 30 years old.

THE APPLICANT MUST SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. A current transcript; college students completing their first year of college should also submit a copy of their high school transcript. If a transcript is not readily available, letters of recommendation must include applicant's potential for success in pursuing the post-secondary education.
- 2. Three letters of recommendation, one each from: (1) a church community source, (2) an academic source, and (3) a community service program.
- 3. Evidence of acceptance into a post-secondary institution.
- 4. A one-page letter, representative of the applicant's writing, which includes each of the following:
 - --Why are you interested in pursuing a post-secondary education?
 - --Why you feel you are worthy of the scholarship?
 - --What are your goals, and how do you hope to achieve those goals?
 - -- A listing of extracurricular activities, accomplishments, and work experience.

The minimal amount of any scholarship will be \$500 which may be awarded to more than one individual.

CLARIFICATION of ITEMS on SCHOLARSHIP CHECKLIST

Cover Page – a separate and specific page that summarizes your application – this page must be completed and signed

Current transcript – this document is a record of your academic accomplishments, it lists every class you have taken and the grade you achieved

Letter of recommendation from a church community source – the individual who writes this letter should have witnessed you participating in or helping out in church sponsored ministry events or activities within the last year

Letter of recommendation from an academic source – should be written by a teacher, guidance counselor, principal or coach within the last year

Letter of recommendation from a community service source – should be written by a community member (outside of a church sponsored event) who you have helped, perhaps picking up trash on Earth Day or helping coach younger children at the community center within the last year

Evidence of acceptance into a post-secondary school or current college transcript – a copy of the acceptance letter to the school you will be attending or copy of current college transcript **One page letter** – a one page letter in which you explain why you are interested in pursuing a post-

secondary education, why you are worthy of this scholarship, what your goals are and how you hope to achieve them, and any accomplishments or work experience.
