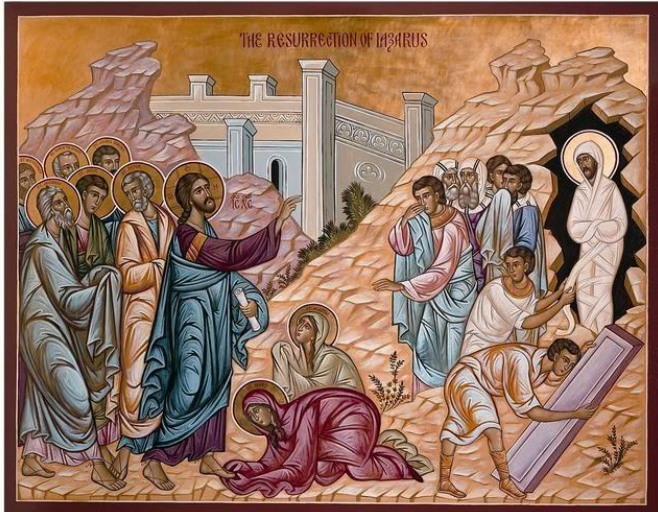


# GOYA Fundraiser: Lazarakia

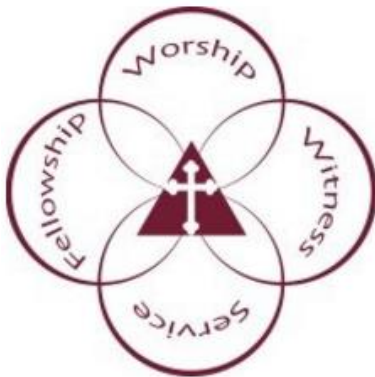

This tradition observes the miracle when our Lord & Saviour Jesus Christ raised His friend Lazarus from the dead after four days in the tomb.

Practiced in **Greece & Cyprus**, the tradition of baking Lazarakia (*Lazarus Breads*) honours this wonderful event and pays respect to St Lazarus. It is worth noting this tradition started in Cyprus where St Lazarus was the first bishop of the island. The arms are folded and the body appears to be wrapped – this is a reminder that St Lazarus was truly dead and wrapped in his burial cloths when Christ came to resurrect him.
