February 11th beginning at 6 p.m.

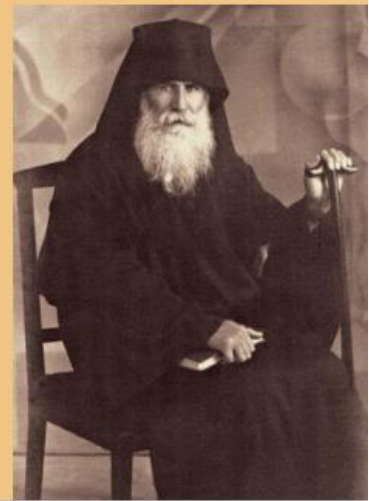
