We remember one of the most important events in the Gospel: the Mystic Supper, when the Lord instituted the mystery of Eucharist.

In cathedrals during the Liturgy bishops wash the feet of 12 people. The preparation of Chrism is finalized. In the evening, on Great Friday matins, we hear 12 selections from the Gospel about the Passion of Christ.

Great Friday



The day of sentencing Christ to death and His Crucifixion. The royal hours are read in the morning. There is no Liturgy - the Sacrifice happens at Calvary. In the afternoon vespers with the elevation of the Shroud are served. St. Joseph of Arimathea removed the Body from the Cross and placed It into the Grave.

The day of strict fast. Many people do not eat at all until the vesperal services are over.

Great Saturday



The Church commemorates the Burial of Christ, his descent into Hell to proclaim there His victory over death and liberate those who had been awaiting Him with faith.

In the morning the Liturgy with 12 readings from the Old Testament about the events and prophecies of the salvation by the death of the Son of God. After the Liturgy paschal baskets are blessed. Holy Fire descends in Jerusalem.
