our responsibility to use the gifts God has entrusted to us, multiplying them by joining the talents together in communion to create so much more than any of us alone can.

Our stewards have shown great generosity already in this new campaign year, with 43 Steward families committing approximately \$127,000 in support to our parish ministries.

We have also seen an increase in stewards offering support of our ministries with their time and talent, and because of this we have been able to get needed committees established to enable our great ministries and programs. Many people have volunteered to support our Food Festival this summer, and more support for this is needed.
