He graduated from Whittier College with a degree in history and graduated from Holy Cross Greek Orthodox Seminary in 1998 with a masters in Divinity. He is currently serving at St. John the Baptist Greek Orthodox Church in Tampa, Florida. He has previously served parishes in Enfield, CT and Asheville, NC. He has more than doubled the size of our parish in 18 years, from 220 families to 450 at present.
