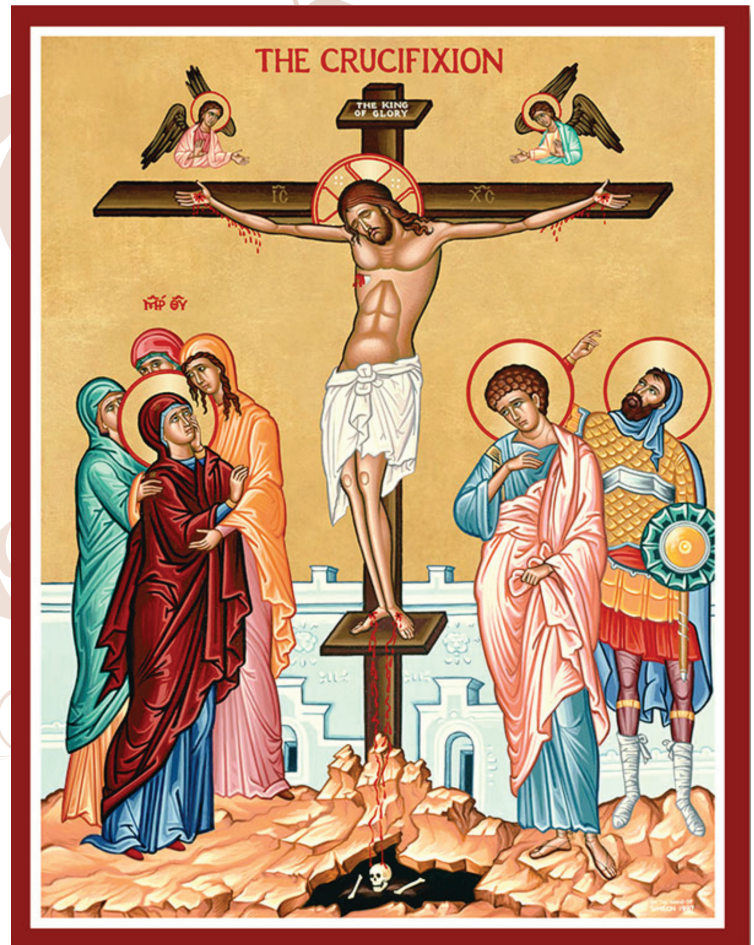

St. Paul prays that he might know the "communion" of Christ's sufferings (Phil 3:10). Often translated as the "fellowship" of Christ's sufferings - such a translation falls short of Orthodox understanding and the literal meaning of the Greek (koinonia). In these two sessions, Fr. Stephen explores the experience and meaning of communion and how it is that the life of Christ becomes our own life.

Fr. Stephen Freeman is an archpriest in the Orthodox Church in America and is the former pastor of St. Anne Orthodox Church in Oak Ridge, Tennessee. He was educated at Furman University, Seabury-Western Theological Seminary, and Duke University. His work has been widely translated and published in Europe and Russia.
