The Bohart Museum, Department of Entomology – A knowledgeable docent will lead our tour of the Bohart Museum, Department of Entomology at UC Davis. We will see parts of the seventh largest insect collection in North America that includes more than 7 million specimens. Bohart Museum studies insects for many reasons: insects are involved in evolution, ecology and public health and are essential in the ecosystem, in pollination, seed disposal, and environmental health. Bohart experts provide legal testing in cases including criminal forensics and product contamination. This museum is among the most important diagnostic resources

on the West Coast.

The Museum of Wildlife and Fish Biology –

We will receive a docent-led tour of The Museum of Wildlife and Fish Biology at UCD. The MWFB houses one of the most significant modern collections of birds, mammals and fish in California. The Department of Wildlife and Fish Conservation Biology was recently <u>ranked #1 in the Nation</u> in research and scholarly output for fisheries and wildlife programs. The MWFB houses over





50,000 specimens and over 5,000 tissues. It is among the top ten collections in California and the third largest university-managed collection in the state.

The Arboretum – The Arboretum is 100 acres spread across the campus and is a living scientific museum with more than 100 classes on campus that use the Arboretum. It is nationally recognized for the research of Oaks and Acacia trees. We will be visiting their newest Garden, The Hummingbird Garden – only about 2 years old. 15% of these birds are vulnerable to extinction and we will learn how perhaps we can help. A Master Gardener will be our tour guide.
