Please note: It is traditional, after receiving the Light, to go outside the church for the proclamation of the Gospel, the singing of Christos Anesti and the beginning of Orthros. Before entering the church, the priest bangs three times on the doors of the church, reenacting our Lord's conquest of death and Hades. The doors are opened and the people follow into the church, an image of entering Paradise.
