About Myrofores

The Myrofores or myrrh-bearing women, came to the tomb of Jesus, very early in the morning, to anoint His Body. In doing so, they showed their courage and love for their Savior. Serving as a Myrofora during Holy Week is one way to serve our Lord on this most holy day.

Girls who would like to be a Myrofora are required to:

- Be in grades 1-6
- wear all white
- including shoes, sweaters/jackets and sock/tights and accessories.

Myrofora can participate in the Holy Friday afternoon Service where we remember the taking the body of our Lord down from the Cross at 3:00 PM; or in the Holy Friday evening Lamentation Service at 7:00 PM or both.

There will be a practice after Church on Palm Sunday followed by a tea for the participating Myrofores.
