The candidate may also be enrolled in an approved college, university, or technical school. Those enrolled in graduate or professional programs may also apply.
- 2. The candidate must be an individual of good moral character.
- 3. The candidate must be enrolled or show evidence of acceptance by an approved college, university or technical school.
- 4. The candidate must be a member or child or grandchild of a member in good standing of Nathan Hale Chapter #58 of AHEPA or of Daughters of Penelope Chapter 198.

The stipulations of said scholarship are as follows:

- 1. Any individual desiring to apply must do so on the form prepared for such purpose and submit the same on or before a date set by the scholarship committee.
- 2. The scholarship shall be for one year and shall be payable to the recipient. No recipient may receive the AHEPA scholarship more than 2 times.
- 3. The Nathan Hale Chapter #58 Scholarship Committee reserves the right to reject any and all applications at any time without assigning any cause whatsoever, and their selection shall remain final.
