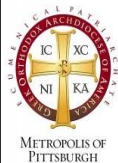

**Eligibility:** - Candidates who are nominated for the Parish Council must be parishioners in good standing of the Parish for at least one year immediately preceding the date of the election and must live their lives in accordance with the Faith and canons of the Church (UPR, Article 25). They must understand that their duties include attending divine services regularly, participating in the sacramental life of the Church (thereby setting an example for the parishioners) and aiding the parish priest in fulfilling the aims and purposes of the parish (UPR, Article 29). The Council President is also expected to represent the parish at the Archdiocesan and Metropolis Clergy-Laity gatherings (or, in their absence, another member of the Council)

**Pre-Election:** - All candidates for election must attend a seminar conducted either by the parish priest or by other clergy and lay leaders within your Metropolis region prior to the date of the election. Any candidate who does not attend the seminar will have their name deleted from the ballot.

**Election:** - An election must always take place. Below we will consider a secret ballot election (the usual method) versus an election by the assembly (for cases when the number of candidates is equal to, or lesser than, the number of available positions). When either (a) more candidates are nominated than available places for election, or (b) the Parish Assembly takes place before the end of the nomination period, then a secret ballot election must be held. When there are a number of candidates equal to or fewer than the open spots for election and when the Parish Assembly takes place on or after the last day of the nomination period, then the Election Committee may move (to the Assembly) that the entire slate be elected by the Assembly. This should be done by formal motion, with the following being an example of the format: "The Election Committee, considering that there are a number of candidates equal to or fewer than the number of available positions, and considering that in these circumstances only one affirmative vote is needed per candidate to secure their election, hereby moves that the Assembly elect the entire slate as present-ed." ο If any one member of the Assembly vocally demands that the election take place via secret ballot (i.e. the usual method), then the motion is set aside, and the election must take place as it would ordinarily.
