ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- I. Greek Orthodox Christian whose parents or legal guardian have been stewards in good standing at St. George Greek Orthodox Cathedral, Hartford for at least the past 2 years, and whose parent has been a member in good standing of the St. George Ladies Philoptochos Society for at least the past 2 years.
- II. Undergraduate or high school senior pursuing full-time
 - A. 2 year or 4 year undergraduate degree at an accredited college or university;
 - B. graduate degree at an accredited college or university; or
 - C. certificate or degree at an accredited post-secondary vocational or technical school.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- I. Completed applications must be delivered to the Scholarship Committee at the address on the last page, postmarked no later than May 31, 2025.
- II. Completed Application must include all of the following:
 - A. **An official, recent transcript from** (1) the applicant's high school transcript for high school seniors or (2) the applicant's college or university for undergraduate applicants.
 - B. **Two letters of character references by** faculty members of the applicant's present school.
 - C. Response to the Essay Question presented below.

Scholarships are awarded for one year. Each applicant may only apply twice and cannot apply in consecutive years. Scholarships are awarded based on academic achievement, character, and leadership qualities. Applicants must meet all eligibility requirements. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Applications are reviewed and treated confidentially by the St. George Philoptochos Scholarship Committee and the Education Fund.
