THE Dr. JAMES C. FASKIANOS SCHOLARSHIP

Overview:

The Dr. James C. Faskianos Family has generously donated funds to the Greek Orthodox Church "The Annunciation" ("The Annunciation") for purposes of establishing an education scholarship fund hereafter referred to as the Dr. James C. Faskianos Scholarship.

General Information:

The Church Scholarship Committee will award this scholarship on an annual basis. The Parish Council shall approve the recommendation of the Church Scholarship Committee annually prior to granting or disbursement of any scholarship funds. The Church Scholarship Committee along with the Parish Council shall have final decision making in the awarding of this scholarship. Disbursement of any monies shall be made to the recipient's school and not to the individual. If a recipient does not begin classes for the school year for which the scholarship is awarded, the award will be nullified and shall be returned to the Dr. James Faskianos Scholarship Fund. Awarding of the scholarship should be based on the following:

- 1) Academic excellence
- 2) Service to the Annunciation Church,
- 3) Service to the community.

Qualifications:

All applicants must meet the following requirements:

- A. Member in good standing of the Annunciation Greek Orthodox Church and who has been attending this church for at least three years with preference given to candidates with longer membership
- B. High school graduate and between the ages of 17 and 25.
- C. Enrolled or have plans of enrolling in a college or vocational school.
- D. Must use funds for undergraduate studies.
- E. Have a grade point average of at least 3.0 (B).

Procedure:

The Church Scholarship Committee shall supply applications for the scholarship. Applicants shall provide all the information requested on the application form by the date set forth by the Church Scholarship Committee. Applicant or applicants selected will be notified by the Church Scholarship Committee by June 15th of the same year. Recipient or recipients of the scholarships may collect the scholarship upon the presentation of verification that he/she is accepted to an accredited college (2 or 4 year) or vocational school.

CLARIFICATION of ITEMS on SCHOLARSHIP CHECKLIST

Cover Page – a separate and specific page that summarizes your application – this page must be completed and signed

Current transcript – this document is a record of your academic accomplishments, it lists every class you have taken and the grade you achieved

Letter of recommendation from a church community source – the individual who writes this letter should have witnessed you participating in or helping out in church sponsored ministry events or activities within the last year

Letter of recommendation from an academic source – should be written by a teacher, guidance counselor, principal or coach within the last year

Letter of recommendation from a community service source – should be written by a community member (outside of a church sponsored event) who you have helped, perhaps picking up trash on Earth Day or helping coach younger children at the community center within the last year Evidence of acceptance into a post-secondary school or current college transcript – a copy of the acceptance letter to the school you will be attending or copy of current college transcript One page letter – a one page letter in which you explain why you are interested in pursuing a post-secondary education, why you are worthy of this scholarship, what your goals are and how you hope to achieve them, and any accomplishments or work experience.
