- 5. Submit the following documents (including those of #3 above)
 - a. A letter from a school official
 - b. A letter from any other source of the applicant's choice
 - c. An official transcript of the current school of attendance

1. The two letters MUST be attached to the application package in sealed, signed envelope from the original writer.

2. The official transcript can be included in the application package if it is in a sealed, signed envelope by the school official. If the school does not give you the official transcript, ask that the application be mailed to the chair of the committee— (Please Note: Please be aware that some educational institutions may take a week or longer to process a request for a transcript. So, act quickly.
